

PATIENT INFORMATION SHEET

24 HOUR URINE COLLECTION

The 24 hour urine specimen is all the urine produced by the body in a 24hr (1 day) period. It must be collected completely and timed accurately to ensure an accurate result.

You will be provided with an orange 24 hour urine bottle.

- Day 1: Upon waking, void your first morning urine into the toilet.
- Write date & time on urine bottle label. This is your start time.
- For the next 24 hours, void all urine into a clean collection vessel (ie: clean plastic container or plastic cup) and immediately transfer urine into the specimen bottle provided by the Laboratory.

CAUTION! This bottle may contain a corrosive preservative. Handle with care! DO NOT VOID DIRECTLY INTO THE BOTTLE. Use the plastic cup then transfer carefully into the bottle.

- Day 2: Upon waking, void all urine from your bladder into a clean container and immediately transfer into the specimen bottle provided by the laboratory. Secure the lid tightly.
- Write date & time on urine bottle label. This is your end time.

The 24 hour collection is now complete. Return specimen to the Laboratory on Day 2 after collection is completed.

NOTE:

- Refrigerate specimen during collection period.
- Keep bottle in upright position at all times.
- Do not fill past 3000 ml mark. Arrange to pick up another jug if needed.
- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
