On-Demand STI Testing

PATIENT INFORMATION

What can I get tested for?

Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, HIV and Syphilis.

If you test too soon after an exposure to a STI, you may not get an accurate result. If you are concerned about a specific sexual contact, we recommend testing at 3 weeks AND 3 months following contact.

Use On-Demand STI Testing when:

- It is part of your regular STI checkup
- Testing is recommended every 3-6 months, especially when you have new or casual partners, or you've had a change in your sexual activities.
- Do NOT use On-Demand STI Testing and see a healthcare provider if:
 - You are having symptoms that you think could be an STI
 - You had recent sexual contact with someone who has tested positive for an STI. Treatment is required and testing with a provider is recommended
 - You want to access HIV Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) or emergency contraception
 - You would like to speak to a nurse or doctor for any other reason

How do I get Tested?

- 1. Fill out the lab form and choose any of the swab tests you would like added (see box for test(s) instructions)
- 2. All of the preselected tests are recommended, but you can choose to cross out any test(s) you don't want.
- Give the lab form back to the lab assistant. They will collect your blood and give you instructions to collect your own urine and/or swab(s) in the bathroom.
 Swab instructions are posted in the bathroom.
- 4. You will **NOT** be seen by a nurse or doctor.

How do I get my results?

Do not call the lab that collected your test samples, they will not have your results.

If your test(s) are **positive** you will be contacted by a nurse who will provide follow-up care and connect you with a provider for treatment

On-Demand STI Testing:

- Chlamydia and Gonorrhea testing:
- For those with internal genitalia (vagina)
 - Choose what collection site you would prefer (urine or vagina).
- For those with external genitalia (penis) choose urine as collection site.

Optional test(s) to add:

On the lab form check the option(s) that match the type of sex you are having.

- Throat Swab My mouth on a partner's penis/ external genitals or shared sex toy
- Rectal Swab A partner's penis/external genitals or shared sex toy in my anus

If your test(s) are **negative** you will **NOT** be contacted.
